## **Supervision and Safety**

This programme is delivered by the Youth Alive Trust. Our supervisors and leaders have been specifically trained in health and safety, behaviour management and skills. There is always at least one first aid trained staff member present.

#### **Behaviour Management**

Parents need to be aware that because safety is our first consideration our policy needs to be strictly adhered to. Parents will be notified if their youth are causing a disruption on the camp. Where serious harm may happen or occurs, or the youth are causing a disruption to the camp, the right to remove the youth immediately from the camp is reserved. If the youth is found to have any illness/behavioural condition that has not been included on the registration form, we reserve the right to remove the young person from the camp.
