





WHAT IS YOUTH ALIVE TRUST?

Youth Alive Trust was established in 1989 to meet the needs of children and young people in New Brighton and surrounding suburbs. We aim to support young people holistically; socially, emotionally, mentally and spiritually through our programmes and our dedicated staff and volunteers.

- Safer Streets Programmes Our after school and evening clubs including: Boys Clubs (Years 1-3 & 4-6), Girls Clubs (Years 1-3 & 4-6), Rock Solid (Years 7-8), Surge (Years 9-13) & Amplify School of Music (Yrs 1-13)
- 2.In-School Programmes Supporting the students in class, during lunchtimes, and extra curricula activities at Rawhiti, South New Brighton, New Brighton Catholic, Avonside Girls and Shirley Boys High Schools (24/7).
- 3. Holiday Programmes These run 4 times a year for three different School Year categories, 1-4's, 5-8's, 9-13's every school holidays, for 100 young people.
- 4. Camps We take youth on trips, camps and weekends away throughout the year, such as Easter Camp, Winter Camp, Famine Sleepover, Samstock and AMPED Camp.
- 5. Library Support We provide Youth Workers in New Brighton Library everyday after school time, on weekends, and during the school holidays.
- 6. Mentoring Meeting one-on-one with young people for relational support, goal setting and affirming encouragement. Some referrals, others connections from our programmes.
- 7. Community Events Large community events such as the Skate Jam, I Love New Brighton, School Fairs, EPIC Dance Parties & our Family Fun Night.
- 8. Family Support Antenatel Classes for young parents, exercise classes for Mum's and tots playgroups.
- 9. Youth Leader training and Support Attracting and training interns and over 50 volunteers to work in their community on our programmes and events.

WHAT IS BOYS CLUB?

Youth Alive Trust runs weekly clubs for all age groups, and Boys Clubs are our new clubs for primary aged boys. Boys can be boys at our club and although we may sometimes join up for larger events with the girls - we don't want to catch their germs! It's led by staff and a group of volunteers who are all police checked and trained. Our senior leaders are part of Grace Vineyard Church. Our programmes have a 10 minute Christian content, when a Christian Value or Bible story is shared, but nothing is forced or coerced on anyone.
