

Support our Dance Studio Project at the Roy Stokes Hall



About the Project

The Roy Stokes Hall was built in the 1970's as a community asset for the east of Christchurch. The main hall is booked everyday by various community groups but there is outcry for more useable community space including a dedicated dance studio. We have the opportunity to convert the West Annex lounge, into a purpose built space, that can be used day and night for dance classes, Zuma, Pilates, fitness classes, martial arts, elderly movement classes and more! It already has an amazing wooden floor, but it's been covered by carpet for decades, so we've got three quotes to sand it back, fill any holes and give it multiple polyurethane coats. We have quotes for new blinds over the windows, sound- proofing between the main hall and the studio space, and we'll also give it a fresh coat of paint, adjust the lighting and hang some mirrors. To build a dance studio from scratch would be hundreds of thousands of dollars but using this existing space, will only cost \$17,500 !! Can you help us by investing into the lives of young and old in our community?!
