HOW OUR PROGRAMME RUNS

Our Programme is designed around a **Rest.Play.Grow** approach. This gives young people the space they need to unwind, explore, and thrive after school.

Each afternoon includes

- **Rest Zones** – quiet, cosy spaces for reading, drawing, unwinding and feeling safe.
- **Creative Play Zones** – building, crafting, imaginative play, sensory materials.
- **Active Play Zones** – outdoor sports, gym games, and movement.
- **STEM & Discovery** – construction, challenges, puzzles, science and problem solving.
- **Daily Optional Activity** – one group activity each day for those who want to join in.
- **Flexible Flow** – children choose the zones they need most, at their pace.

Young people can choose to get involved in YAT's weekly clubs, all held in the same building. These clubs offer extra opportunities for belonging, confidence building and trying new activities that match their interests. If a young person decides to attend a club, our team supports a smooth, supported transition straight from OSCAR into their session.
